

Language for Contracts

The Tobacco Free Emory Task Force, working with the office of the General Counsel, has developed language that should be included in contracts to ensure that the companies doing business on campus are aware of Emory's new Tobacco-Free Policy.

It is recommended that the language below be included in all contracts that require vendors to be present on Emory's campus:

Vendor acknowledges that Emory University is a tobacco-free campus to improve the health of its community members, as such the use or sale of tobacco products in or on Emory-owned or Emory-leased property is prohibited. This policy applies to faculty, staff, students, contractors, vendors and visitors. The use of tobacco products, including smokeless tobacco, clove cigarettes and e-cigarettes, is not permitted on any university-owned or leased property, which includes but is not limited to, buildings, university grounds, parking areas, walkways, recreational and sporting facilities and university-owned vehicles. This prohibition includes smoking in personal vehicles parked on university grounds.
